Energy Savings Case Study

Property: Fieldstone Farm 800 Hydric Ct. Odenton, MD 21113

Date of Multi-Family BGE Quick Home Energy Check-up Service: March 18 to March 21, 2013

Summary:

Fieldstone Farm apartments, owned by The Dolben Company, Inc. has one, two and three bedroom apartments for rent. From March 18 to 21, 2013, greeNEWit serviced the premises of Fieldstone Farm with a Quick Home Energy Check-up (QHEC) and installed a total of 1,541 CFL light bulbs, 359 faucet aerators and 176 showerheads in 138 units on the premises. These energy upgrades will prevent nearly 45 tons of CO2 from being released into the atmosphere; the CO2 saved is equivalent of nearly 226 trees being planted.

Type of Service:

The following actions were taken by greeNEWit energy retrofit technicians in each in-unit QHEC:

- ☑ Visually inspected HVAC systems, water heaters, appliances, windows, lighting choices, and possible health and safety issues.
- Recorded existing conditions and suggested recommendations for improvements.
- ☑ Educated residents on how to further reduce the amount of energy they use on a daily basis.
- Created instant energy savings by directly installing measures wherever standard conditions existed (i.e. replaced incandescent light bulbs with CFLs, replaced both showerheads and faucet aerators with efficient-flow alternatives.)
