Energy Savings Case Study

Property: Truman Park 601 Harry S. Truman Dr. Largo, MD 20774

Date of Multi-Family Pepco Quick Home Energy Check-up Service: December 3 to December 11, 2012

Summary:

Truman Park apartments in Largo, Maryland is a luxury apartment community with an array of amenities. From December 3 to 11, 2012, greeNEWit serviced the premises of Truman Park with a Quick Home Energy Check-up (QHEC) and installed a total of 4,035 CFL light bulbs, 662 faucet aerators, 379 showerheads and 846 feet of pipe insulation in 255 units on the premises. These energy upgrades will prevent nearly 221,528 pounds of CO2 from being released into the atmosphere.

Type of Service:

The following actions were taken by greeNEWit energy retrofit technicians in each in-unit QHEC:

- ☑ Visually inspected HVAC systems, water heaters, appliances, windows, lighting choices, and possible health and safety issues.
- ☑ Recorded existing conditions and suggested recommendations for improvements.
- Educated residents on how to further reduce the amount of energy they use on a daily basis.
- Created instant energy savings by directly installing measures wherever standard conditions existed (i.e. replaced incandescent light bulbs with CFLs, replaced both showerheads and faucet aerators with efficient-flow alternatives.)
